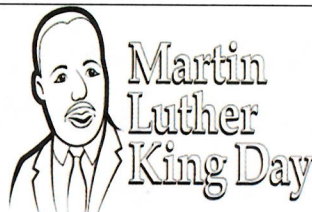

Otter Tail County has approved a program to spur new investment in single and two family homes. The goal is to open up lower value, existing home stock to new home buyers as well as increase the tax base through a rebate of property taxes on newly constructed homes.

Program overview:

- Rebate of the County's portion of the property tax increase, along with the City's portion in participating cities (currently Fergus Falls, Ottertail, Pelican Rapids and **Vergas**)
- Primary residences only (no seasonal owners)
- Provides up to \$10,000 in rebate in five years (\$5,000 throughout the county plus \$5,000 if in residence being built is located in a participating city)
- Rebate paid to the owner of record in December of the year, transfers with sale of the property
- Approval must be received before construction begins
- Applicant can be future homeowner or builder/developer
