#### **November Mayor's Message**


The City of Vergas continues to leverage the use of technology to create more efficient and cost- effective city operations. At the October 10th City Council meeting 2 new systems were approved.

The first is the Insight SCADA web site and cellular system for the water plant and lift stations. This system provides a 24 hour a day alert service when there are attention needs. This will provide ongoing timely alerts and also results in maintenance staff no longer needing to routinely come in on weekends to just read meters at the water/sewer plant; saving 208 hours annually.

The other new system is Minibilling. This system would replace the current UBMAX used by the City for utility billing. The new system provides the ability to pay water/sewer bills right out of your bank account as a monthly debit; referred to as ACH payments. It will also send the City Newsletter. This is a system widely used across companies and has a significant impact on labor in putting together paper bills and the associated costs of paper/envelopes and postage. Signing up for this service, residents will receive a \$1.00 credit each month as emailed bills and ACH payments is more cost effective.

There will be a transition time in establishing the new systems, so at this time there is no exact date for implementation. Anticipate early in 2024.
