Spring Cleaning

With the mild winter we've had, the arrival of spring isn't quite as dramatic as most years. Spring or springtime by many is considered a season of rebirth or rejuvenation. Windows get washed, last falls's leaves get raked and hauled to recycling, and we wait for things to start popping up in our gardens and flower beds.

It's also a good time of the year to cleanup some of those things we may have been looking at all winter. The City of Vergas has a number of Ordinances that deal with "nuisances". They're in place to keep our City looking great, not only for those who live here, but also for those who visit.

A number of "typical" issues that the Planning Commission deals with annually, include:

- -inoperable motor vehicles. All vehicles must be currently licensed.
- -unlawful parking and storage. Things like fish houses, storage sheds, etc. must be 100' back from the front property line.
- -building maintenance and appearance. Buildings, fences, and other structures that have been so poorly maintained that their physical condition and appearance detract from the surrounding neighborhood can be declared public nuisances.
- -public health nuisances can include pet waste accumulations and garbage can/receptacles that do not close properly.
- -accumulations in the open of discarded machinery, appliances, or any other material (garbage) that can create health or safety concerns.
- -fires in the City of Vergas, excluding recreational fires, need proof of a DNR permit.
- -Ordinances can differ between commercial and residential areas.

City Staff and members of the Planning Commission are here to answer any questions and work with you regarding these Ordinances. City staff and Planning Commission members will be conducting compliance inspections the week of May 13th. Together, let's work on making Vergas a beautiful place we all want to call home.


Spring has sprung! Let the fun begin with a new feature at VMLS...

The City of Vergas has a Community Fund for projects not covered by our city budget. Past projects included the Trail/Boardwalk, Event Center Remodel, Pickleball Courts and Veteran's Memorial. Event Center Fund: Funds to be used for building updates such as kitchen remodel, new roof and an accordion door to separate the bar form the large area. Park Fund: Funds to be used for upkeep and replacing buildings and providing items to increase the use and safety of our parks. The current project includes replacing the bathhouse at the Long Lake Beach Park.
